Nassau County Executive **Laura Curran** is the 9th County Executive in County history and the first woman elected to the office. She previously served as a member of the Nassau County Legislature and was an adjunct professor of journalism at SUNY Purchase, after beginning her career in journalism.

Curran, who represents more than 1.3 million residents, has said her priorities are reestablishing faith and trust at the highest levels of government, working with local municipalities to foster economic development and regional projects that support and enhance the use of mass transit, and to restore order to a county budget process that historically yields deficits.

Immediately upon taking office, Curran introduced contracting reform package, several administrative measures to establish ethical standards and transparency within the contracting process itself. She also issued a first-of-its-kind executive order barring any member of her staff from holding a position of authority in a political party or committee.
