



APPLICATION – The Madelyn Orsini Award

The Madelyn Orsini Award is presented annually to a female student who demonstrates the values of the WEDLI organization by her commitment to leadership and community service on Long Island.

Applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Nominated by an active member of WEDLI or by a faculty member at the applicant's attending university or college;
- Have a future career goal focused on promoting economic growth and development on Long Island;
- Currently resides in Nassau, Suffolk, Brooklyn or Queens County;
- Attends an institution of higher education in Nassau, Suffolk, Brooklyn or Queens County; and
- Successfully completed at least two years of undergraduate or one year of graduate coursework.

WEDLI members are not eligible for the award; family members are eligible.

Application deadline: April 15, 2021. Award winners will be determined by May 1, 2021, and presented with the award at our Legislative meeting in May.
