Applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Nominated by an active member of WEDLI or by a faculty member at the applicant's post-secondary school or educational program.
 - Currently resides in Nassau, Suffolk, Kings (Brooklyn) or Queens County.
 - Attends an institution of higher education in Nassau, Suffolk, Kings (Brooklyn) or Queens County.
 - Successfully completed one year of coursework from any of the following post-secondary schools/educational programs: undergraduate; graduate; vocational; or technical.
- WEDLI members are not eligible for the award; family members are eligible.

Application deadline: February 16, 2024. Award winners will be determined by March 15, 2024, and presented with the award at our breakfast meeting in April.
